Gather a large group of invested members.

Ask these three questions: 1. Who are we, and why are we here? 2. What values define the way we

do ministry? 3. What do we hope to accomplish in the next three years?

Allow time for brainstorming on each of the questions.

Allow time for conversation about each question until everyone has had a chance to contribute.

Choose goals that scare you a little. Goals you can't do alone.

Keep the group focused on the task at hand.

Communicate the mission, values, and goals to everyone and continue to celebrate progress as you move toward accomplishing your goals.

DON'T....

Do this work alone.

Limit this conversation to leadership.

Allow one person to dominate the conversation.

Rush the process.

Fail to communicate your mission, values, and goals.

Undervalue the importance of this work.

Allow the successful ministry of the past to keep you from dreaming of change in the future.
